# RESPONDENTS

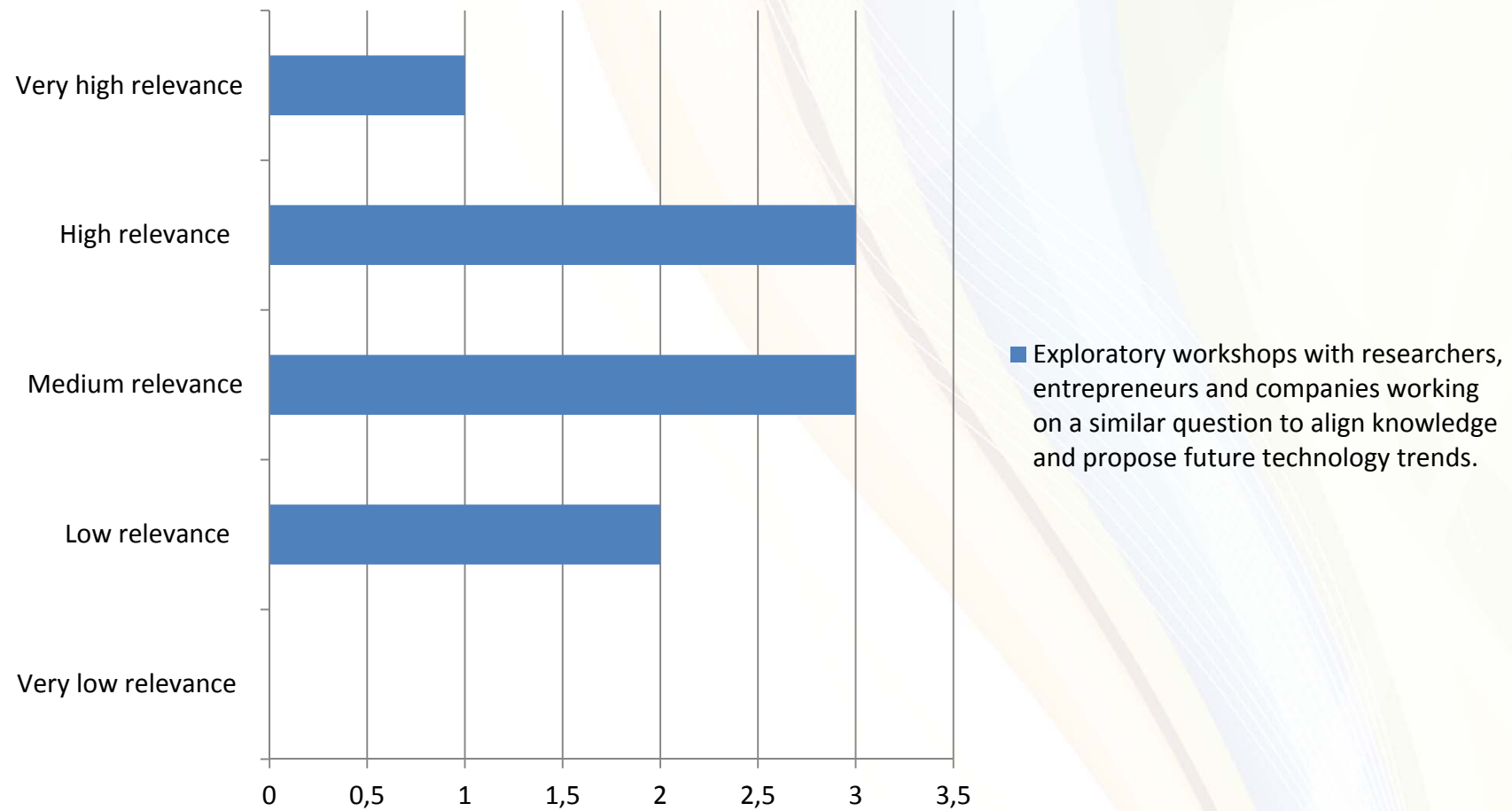

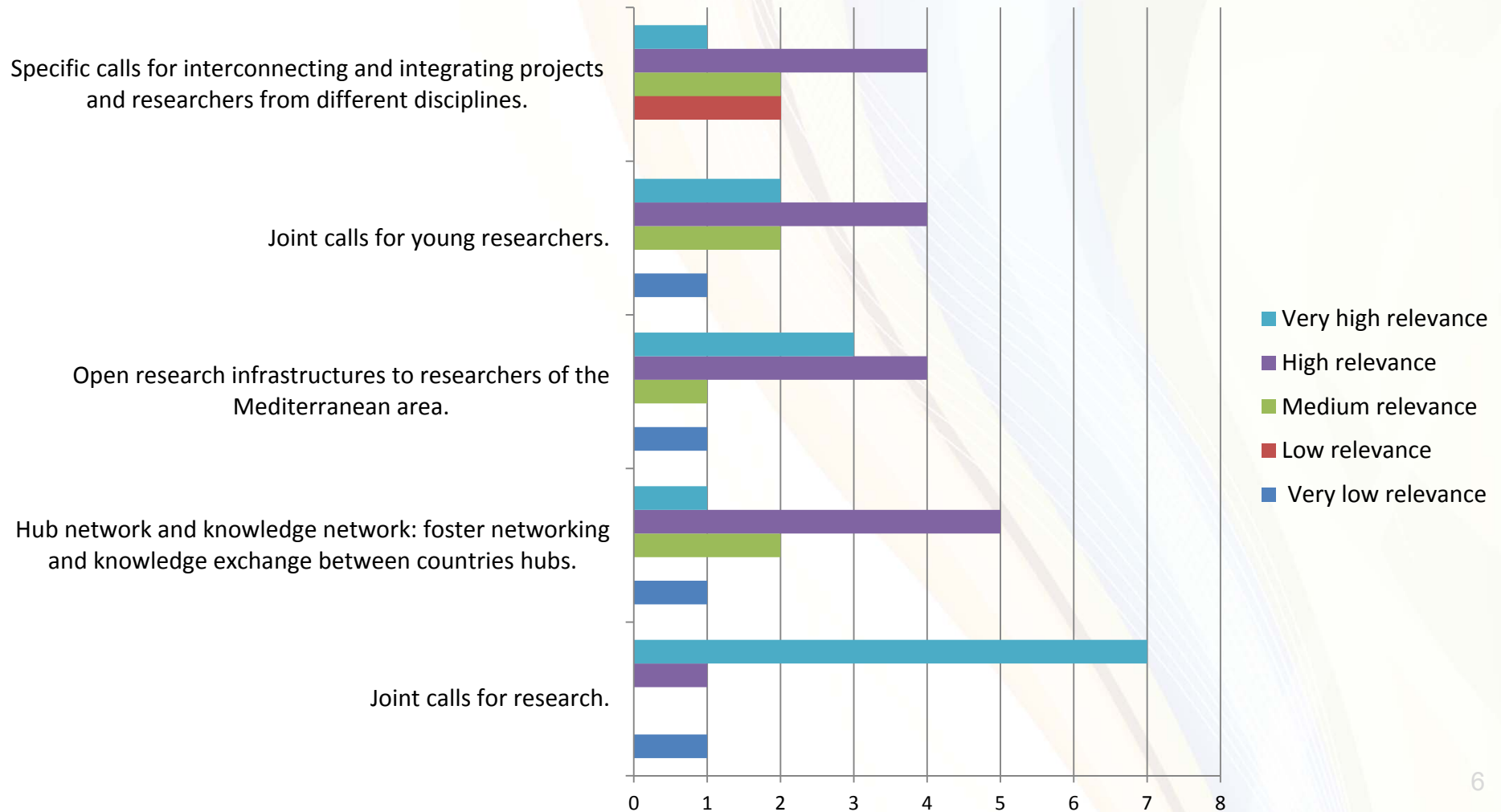

## ACTIVITY THAT ALLOW TO EXPLORE EMERGING RESEARCH AREAS



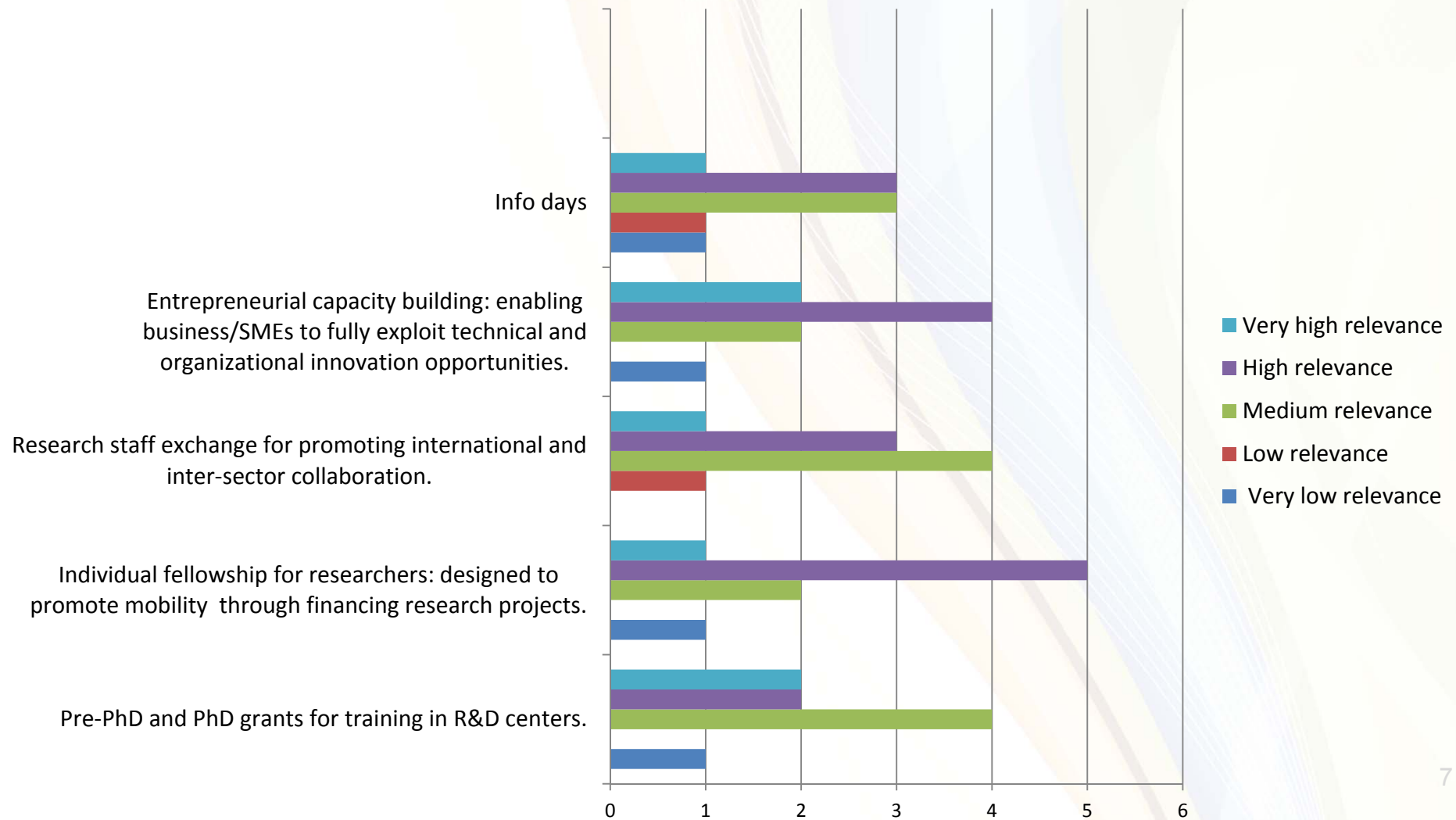

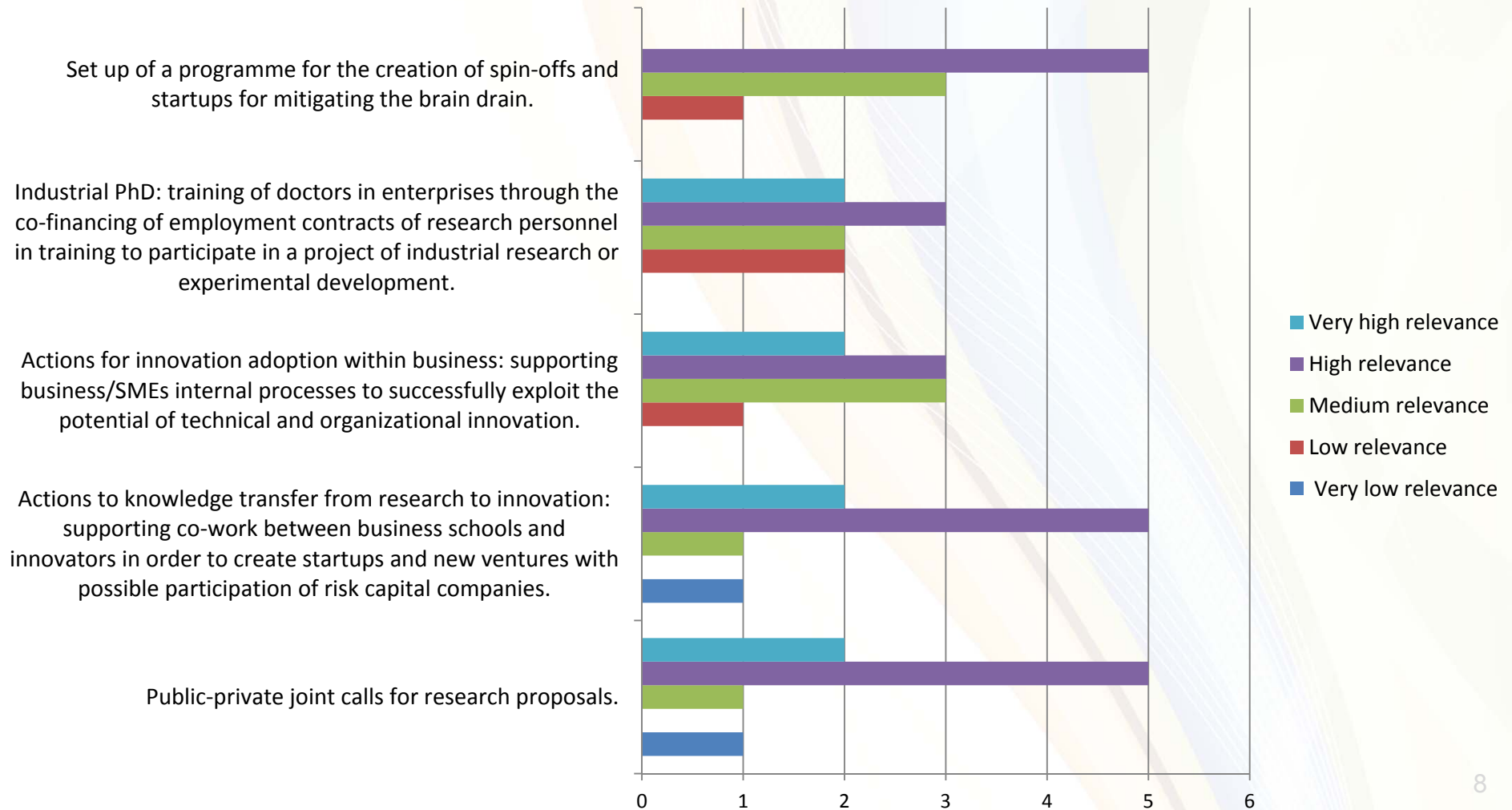

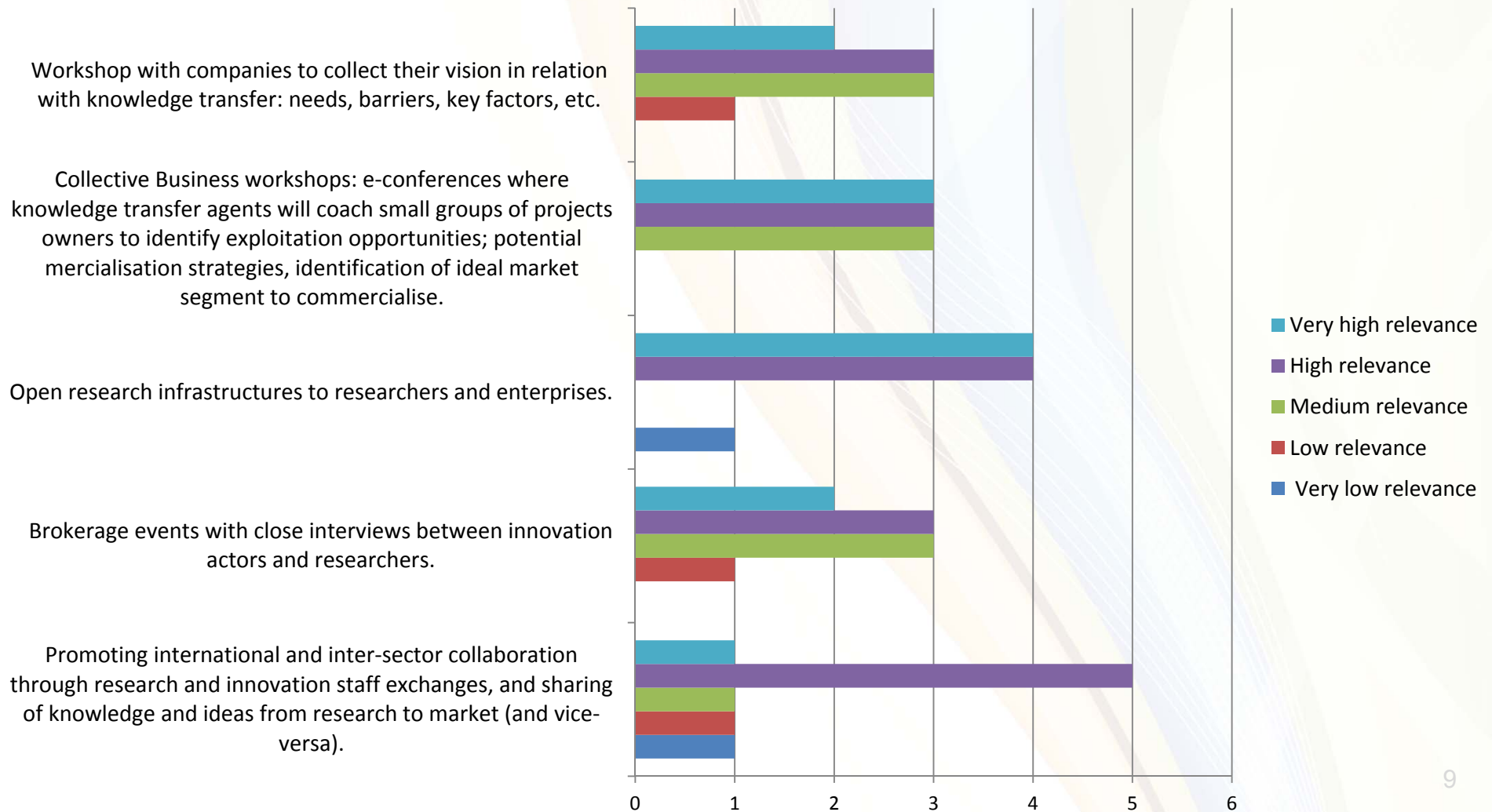

- Set up of a programme for the creation of spin-offs and startups for mitigating the brain drain.
- Activities for knowledge transfer from research to innovation: supporting co-work between business schools and innovators in order to create startups and new ventures with possible participation of risk capital companies.
